

**Rocky Mountain Conference
Teen Rep Commitment Contract**

Outlines a young person's dedication to a leadership program, confirming their understanding of responsibilities and willingness to participate actively. The teen leader commitment activities include:

Teen Rep Commitment:

- **Full participation:** Confirmation that the student will attend all program dates and actively engage in all activities.
- **Understanding of guidelines:** Acknowledgment that they understand the program rules and expectations.
- **False information:** A statement that they understand that providing false information can disqualify them from the program.
- **Good standing:** Confirmation that they are in good academic standing and have passing grades.
- **Active involvement:** A commitment to be an active participant in all activities and events.
- **Effort to obtain materials:** A statement that they will make an effort to obtain any necessary materials or information, especially if they miss a meeting.
- **Attendance:** A commitment to attend all RMC calendar activities that involve teen leadership participation such as: Adventurer Fun Day, Pathfinder Fair Day, Pathfinder Camporee organization and teen activities, assist and help out at Leadership weekend, organize and prepare Teen Lock-In weekend, teen Summit, and Council weekend. Other additional activities might added and informed at a later time.
- **Parent agreement:** Parents need to acknowledge that they understand the time commitment and responsibilities of the program. Confirmation from a parent or guardian acknowledging that they will support Teen's Rep participation, attendance and provide necessary support.
